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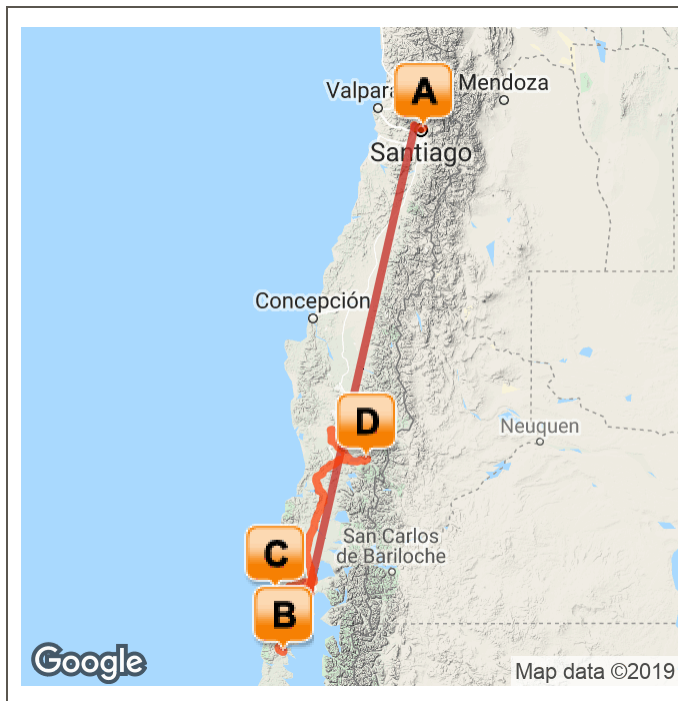

Tierra Hotel Chiloé

Chiloe Island, Chile

Day 2

After your breakfast you will be drove to Santiago airport in order to board your domestic flight to Puerto Montt. At your arrival, a representative of Tierra Chiloe will drive you to the hotel located in Chiloé Island.

The spectacular Tierra Chiloe is tucked away amidst the breathtaking surrounds of the Chiloe Archipelago, in Chile's northern Patagonia region. Here, on an island surrounded by azure waters and charming picturesque fishing villages, guests can take in the world-class architecture of the hotel that combines traditional Chiloé craftsmanship with modern designs. Just 12 rooms ensure an exclusive Chilean experience. Each room is exceptionally decorated to showcase the island's vibrant, ancient culture and features a lovely ensuite bathroom.

Guests can embark on a series of tailor-made adventures, which include cultural excursions, horseback riding, biking and hiking, in the company of bilingual guides. Each adventure is limited to a maximum of eight guests per guide ensuring you get the most out of your experience. Tierra Chiloé also own its own luxurious boat, the Williche, which offers guests a wonderful opportunity to explore the inland waters. After a successful day of sightseeing, guests can unwind in the soul-soothing spa or tuck into distinctively Chiloe-inspired menus

Day 3 & 4

The hotel offers a number of included activities, below you will find a non-exhaustive list. We recommend you discuss your interest and fitness with the guides of the hotel.

HALF DAY TRIPS - BY LAND

Backyard Pullao (Easy)

This tour is ideal for exploring the area around the hotel, our greenhouse and sustainable kitchen garden that includes a plant nursery, stables and a compost area. Here we can also see the Pullao Wetlands, part of the Western Hemisphere Shorebird Reserve Network (WHSRN). Depending on the time of year, we might spot scientifically-important migratory birds such as godwits, Chilean flamingos, cormorants, ducks and gulls. There are also salmon farms, mussel farms and seaweed collectors.

Historic Castro

This tour follows the tides to show you the traditional palafitos (stilt houses) of the island's capital. We visit the picturesque Yumbel Market selling typical regional products such as Chiloé potatoes, giant garlic, baskets, weavings and a wide variety of seafood. We see the inspiration for Chiloé's classic postcard:



the colourful stilt homes and charming downtown with small craft shops and wood-shingled stores. We continue on our way to the Catholic church of San Francisco which is the capital's main one, declared a National Monument and UNESCO World Heritage Site. We also visit the shipyard, birthplace of our boat "Williche," and see local boats being built. Finally, we visit Nercon church, which nicely represents the Chiloé Wooden Architecture School.

FULL DAY TRIPS - BY LAND

Bosquepiedra - Land of Myrtle (Difficulty Level Easy)

We start the day by visiting Huillinco Lake, Chiloé's biggest and part of the watershed system so important to island life. Then, we take a magical path through an evergreen native forest with cinnamon, coigüe, hazelnut and mañio trees, and a wide variety of ferns and lichen. After lunch, on the way back to the hotel we meet a local farmer who shows us her myrtle crop and invites us to enjoy a typical Chiloé bonfire around which she shares her stories.

Chonchi Lemuy Island - Pindal Forest (Difficulty Level High)

We travel to Chonchi, a traditional fishing town, situated upon three natural terraces that conserve its identity and tradition. We visit the historic church whose vaulted roof is painted blue, sprinkled with white stars. We head towards the coast road, walking down the town's most typical street, declared a National Monument for its traditional large wooden houses, which reflect the wealth generated by an increase in cypress exploitation. We visit the local "Chonchina Traditions Museum," founded by the villagers to preserve their own history and show how the first inhabitants lived. We visit the charming Chilote accordion museum, born of folklorist and local music legend Sergio Colivoro's passion for the instrument. Continuing towards the coast road, we pass by the local craft market where you can also buy traditional Chonchina doughnuts and typical Chiloé "golden liquor."

We cross Lemuy Island to visit three churches that are World Heritage sites: Ihuac, Detif and Aldachildo. We enjoy various panoramic views before arriving at the Pindal Reserve, a native forest with coigües, arrayanes and cinnamon trees. The song of the chucao bird transports us to the deepest depths of Chiloé's wilderness

FULL DAY TRIPS - BY SEA

Mechuque

This excursion is one of our best. It allows for full immersion in Chiloé culture and nature as we sail through the waterways between the islands of the archipelago. We start at the hotel and travel by car to the magical town of Tenaun, land of witches and legends, to see the only heritage church on the island. Then we board our private boat, the "Williche," and head towards Mechuque Island to view its original palafitos (stilt houses), the school which is a National Monument and a private



collection of antiques typical of the area. We visit the Don Checo Museum, where we experience life firsthand on Chiloé and the strong relationship between Chilotes and their surroundings. Possible activities include kayaking in the channels enjoying the tranquility of the water; a Zodiac ride through the waterways whilst looking out for birds; and hiking up to Mechuque lookout with its privileged view of the Andes.

HORSEBACK

The village of San Jose (Difficulty Level: Easy)

After a brief explanation of safety rules and how to ride a horse, we head out from the stables toward the heart of the village of San Jose. This tour allows for connection with the surroundings through its wonderful places, diverse wild plants and flowers and unique views of the Andes Mountains, making it not-to-be-missed

Pellul - Quento Beach (Difficulty Level: High)

Moving west from the stables, we pass by fields, towns and churches until we reach our destination: Quento Beach. There we have a panoramic view toward Castro, the capital of Chiloé. Depending on the tides, we start our horseback ride along the beach. According to the time of year, it is possible to see and taste the island's wild fruit. We lunch in the area.

BICYCLE

There are many different trails with levels varying from medium-easy to difficult. We can make recommendations regarding the desired level before you set out so that you have the best experience and get to know the most attractive areas near the hotel. The rides begin from the hotel toward the village of San Jose where you can see local life close up, riding through woods and open fields, and past the church and cemetery. The entire path is unpaved with a privileged view of the coastal mountains.

SPECIAL INTEREST - SPORT FISHING

(This activity is provided at an extra cost)

Length: Half or full day. Fishing in Chiloé is an unforgettable experience. The excursions take place in the most beautiful part of the archipelago and are designed for expert fishermen, amateurs and all who are interested in trying their hand at fishing. The excursions take you to beaches, rivers and lakes in the southern part of Chiloé National Park (Huillinco-Cucao), where local guides who know the area accompany you. In these surroundings of unparalleled beauty, you can enjoy lake and river-fishing of fario and brown trout (dominant species), rainbow trout and even saltwater fish such as red snapper and silver smelt. On the Pacific beaches, we can take pleasure in fishing sea bass, red snapper and even flounder. Salmon fishing is only allowed in Chiloé between the months of November and May. There are no limits to fishing in the sea.

Day 8

After your breakfast, you will have an overland journey to andBeyond Vira Vira lodge located close to Pucón in the northern Chilean Lake District. On your day of arrival, in the afternoon, an activity will be provided by the hotel, giving you your first taste of the area.

Generally considered as the adventure capital of Chile, the area around Pucón offers a myriad of outdoor activities such as rafting, hiking, skiing, kayaking, and fly-fishing. There is however far much more to this multi-faceted destination. Among its many natural highlights, there are wonderful thermal springs and gorgeous national parks. Volcanoes, mountains, and lakes create one of the most beautiful natural sites Chile has to offer.

During your stay, you will have several full days of activities arranged by the hotel.

The area is a traveller's dream when it comes to adventures and choice of activities. The many surrounding natural parks, the majestic volcano Villarrica with its unbelievable views, water sports, horseback riding, and trekking in the foothills of the Andes, are a vital part of the experience at Vira Vira.
