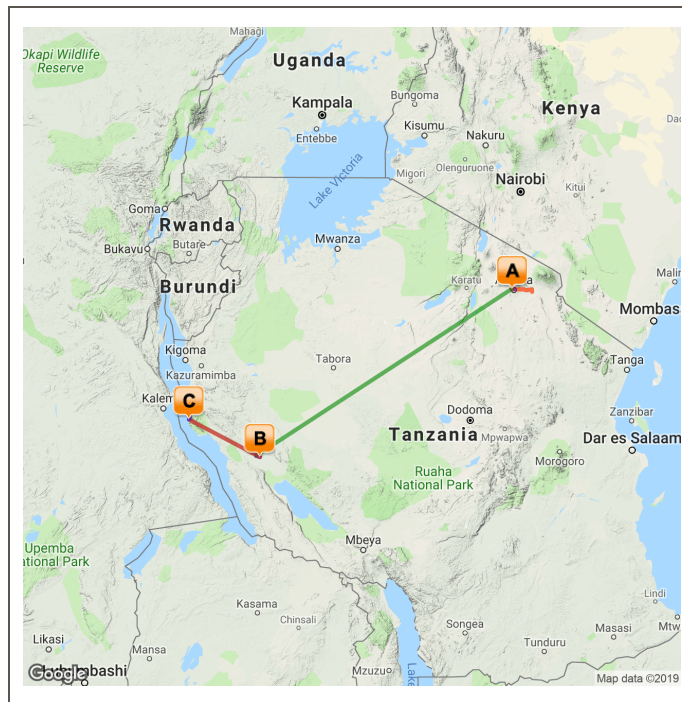

### Elewana Arusha Coffee Lodge

*Arusha, Tanzania*

The aptly named Arusha Coffee Lodge lies hidden amongst the sprawling grounds of Tanzania's largest coffee plantation below the rugged peaks of Mt Meru. Guests can unwind in one of the lodge's prized plantation suites, which each boast a romantic four-poster bed draped in Egyptian cotton linen, a split-level sitting area, ensuite bathroom, mosquito nets, ceiling fans, an open fireplace, personal bar and private veranda, which overlook rows and rows of berry-laden coffee bushes.

Guests can enjoy scrumptious meals in the Coffee Lodge lounge or sip on their favourite drinks in the bar area. A boutique store, swimming pool and garden terrace add to guest delight. For additional costs optional adventures include a tour at the Shanga Shanga coffee plantation, as well as visits to the Museum of Natural History, the Maasai market on Faya Road and the world's only tanzanite mine. A game drive in Mt Meru National Park, accompanied by a delicious picnic lunch, makes a wonderful outing.

*Katavi National Park, Tanzania*

#### Day 2 - 4

A member from our andBeyond team will collect you from Arusha Coffee Lodge and drive you to Arusha Airport for your scheduled flight to Southern Katavi Airstrip.

Katavi National Park in the far west of Tanzania is somewhere that even today, few people have been lucky enough to visit. Perhaps because of this, it feels untouched, almost like travelling back in time.

Explore and unwind during your 3 night stay at Chada Katavi in a Tent with ensuite bathroom.

Your stay includes all meals, safari activities; Game Drives, Walking Safaris, Fly camping; scheduled road transfers to/from Katavi (Ikuu) airstrip, drinks (excluding champagne and premium wines) and laundry.

### Chada Katavi

*Katavi National Park, Tanzania*

Nestled under the mottled shade of large acacia and tamarind trees, on the edge of the scenic Chada floodplain is the beautiful Chada Katavi - a secluded classic safari-styled camp, remotely situated to offer its guests unrivalled game viewing in pristine wilderness. Six beautifully furnished tents boast fine wooden furniture, oh-so comfy beds, and a lovely bush bathroom set behind the tent.

From its elevated vantage point, Chada Katavi offers its guests breath-taking panoramic views, which can be enjoyed from the privacy of the tents or from the beautifully appointed dining area. Katavi National Park is home to a plethora of wildlife. Here guests can view vast herds of buffalo, elephants and an assortment of stealthy predators. Adventures include twice-daily game drives in open 4x4 safari vehicles, bush walks with an armed guide and fly camping which will take guests to the heart of Katavi's untamed wilderness.

### Greystoke Mahale

*Mahale Mountain National Park, Tanzania*

#### Day 5 - 8

After a mouth-watering breakfast you will be transferred to the airstrip for your scheduled flight departing from Katavi Airstrip to Mahale (Ikuu) Airstrip. From the Airstrip you will then take a boat transfer to Greystoke Mahale.

Delight in your 4 night stay at Greystoke Mahale in an Open-fronted Banda with open air bathrooms.

Your stay includes all meals, activities on a shared basis (chimp trekking, boat trips, deep water swims, forest walks, and Village visits), return boat transfers (Mahale airstrip), drinks (except champagne premium wines), laundry, catch & release fishing and park camping fees.

## Greystoke Mahale

*Mahale Mountain National Park, Tanzania*

With its charismatic ‘Robinson Crusoe’ atmosphere, Greystoke Mahale radiates an undeniable air of adventure. It is located at the foot of the densely forested Mahale Mountains, home to a thriving population of chimpanzees. Luxury bandas are open-fronted to offer the very best views of Lake Tanganyika and the adjoining bathrooms are accessible by means of raised wooden walkways. An upstairs viewing deck offers a tranquil haven after a rewarding day of chimp viewing. The guest area, casually named ‘The Mess’, is loosely modelled on traditional Tongwe architecture. It consists of a bar, dining area, library and small raised platforms that have been converted into cosy sitting areas and boast superb views of the Lake. Guests can indulge in a variety of sumptuous dishes. Private dinners by candlelight on the beach can be arranged. Adventures include chimpanzee safaris, snorkelling, kayaking and fishing.
