Known locally as Mosi-oa-Tunya (the smoke that thunder), this is undoubtedly one of the world's greatest natural spectacles. Here you will have the opportunity to take advantage of nearby adventures such as an unforgettable helicopter flight over the Victoria Falls, sunset cruises and hiking. Next, you will venture to the beautiful Hwange National Park. Renowned as an elephant stronghold, Zimbabwe's largest national park offers a variety of landscapes, from desert sands and sparse woodland to grasslands and rocky outcrops. Spend your days exploring your surrounds on game drives and walking safaris. The last leg of your adventure takes you to the remote destination of Mana Pools National Park, which is tucked away within the middle of the Zambezi Valley. Here, you will unwind and enjoy exciting activities in the bush.

The Elephant Camp Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe, Zimbabwe

Day 1 - 2

Upon arrival at Victoria Falls International Airport you will be met by The Elephant Camp representative who will transfer you by road to The Elephant Camp.

Victoria Falls is one of the world's greatest natural spectacles. Declared a World Heritage Site, the Falls are the stuff of legends, romance and myth. Dr David Livingstone 'discovered' the Falls in 1855, the local Batonga people had named them Mosi-oa-Tunya, 'the smoke that thunders'. Today, the village rightly claims the title of Adrenaline Capital of Africa, home to a seemingly endless variety of adventure sports from bungee jumping to canoeing and white water rafting.

Explore the sights of Victoria Falls during your 2 night stay at The Elephant Camp in a Tented Suite with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes all meals, drinks, mini bar, return Victoria Falls Airport / Livingstone Airport transfers & shuttle transfers to Victoria Falls town, Emergency Medical Evacuation cover and activities (Cocktails & Canapés at the Batoka Gorge, Birding & Nature walks on the Wild Horizons Wildlife Sanctuary, lunch at the Lookout Cafe - Including drinks and a Victoria Falls Canopy Tour.

The Elephant Camp

Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe, Zimbabwe

Set on a private concession with spectacular views of the mists rising over the majestic Victoria Falls and the steeply carved gorges of the Zambezi River, The Elephant Camp is an intimate luxury lodge under canvas. Twelve luxury tented suites boast magnificent views of the rocky gorges, and spacious four-poster beds beckon you to a peaceful night's rest. Private viewing decks feature plunge pools just big enough for two, and bathrooms feature luxury Victoria + Albert bathtubs looking onto breathtaking bush panoramas. Outdoor showers feature stone flooring blending the indoors and out. Shared guest areas include spacious decks as well as a cosy lounge, bar and dining area. Sit in the sunken firepit and swap your captivating safari stories around a blazing fire. Shady tented spaces lead out onto a sun- kissed pool where comfortable loungers gaze onto sweeping vistas of Batoka Gorge. All suites have been installed with USB charging ports, and fibre optic Wi-Fi runs throughout the camp.

Relish delicious meals and sundowners in private seating areas, or on the main dining deck, and create your own delicious wood fire pizza in the pizza oven at lunch.

Within easy reach of Victoria Falls, yet secluded on its own game reserve, The Elephant Camp offers community and conservation focused activities including an elephant experience and visit to the Victoria Falls Wildlife Trust. All adrenalin based activities can be easily added to your itinerary.

WHAT WE LOVE ABOUT THE ELEPHANT CAMP

- Indulge in a relaxing spa treatment on the viewing deck of your suite, or at the spa, followed by an invigorating outdoor shower while taking in the distant views.
- Ask your hosts to arrange sundowner drinks (with their famous gin and tonic, of course) at the head of the gorge, listening to the rushing waters of the Zambezi River far below.



African Bush Camps Somalisa Camp Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe

Day 3 - 5


After an early breakfast you will be transferred to Victoria Falls International Airport for your scheduled charter flight to Manga Airstrip followed by a short game drive to Somalisa Camp.

Hwange National Park, is Zimbabwe's largest national park. Here guests can explore a variety of landscapes, from desert sands and sparse woodland to grasslands and rocky outcrops. Vast herds of elephant and buffalo, gemsbok and packs of brown hyena can be found in this pristine slice of wilderness, which also boasts one of the largest surviving populations of wild dog.

Explore Hwange during your 3 night stay at Somalisa Camp in a Tent with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes all meals, beverages, laundry, emergency medical evacuation insurance (Personal Travel Insurance still required), National Parks Fees, return road transfers from Manga Airstrip, two shared activities per full day, (private vehicle required at associated costs for Mambanje Village Visit).

African Bush Camps Somalisa Camp Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe

Situated on a floodplain in the middle of Hwange National Park, Somalisa Camp boasts elegantly furnished canvas tents with ensuite bathrooms, flush toilets and romantic al fresco bush showers. The pool and the stunning guest area overlook the pan. The sitting room and dining areas are tucked under a soaring canopy of trees.

Guests will feast on innovative gourmet meals, complemented by a superb selection of South African and Australian wines. Adventures on offer include bush walks led by qualified and passionate guides, morning and evening game drives in open 4x4 safari vehicles, and game viewing from hides. The resident wildlife includes elephant, kudu, sable antelope, zebra, wildebeest, gemsbok, the rare and endangered roan antelope, buffalo, giraffe, white rhino, lion, leopard and hyena, amongst others.

- Spend a leisurely afternoon spotting game from the camp's hides.

African Bush Camps Kanga Camp Mana Pools National Park, Zimbabwe

Day 6 - 7

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Manga Airstrip for your scheduled charter flight to Mana Pools Airstrip which will be followed by a short game drive transfer to Kanga Camp.

An exciting adventure awaits you as you will explore this unique remote wilderness area in Zimbabwe.

Escape and explore during your 3 night stay at Kanga Camp in a Tent with ensuite facilities with bucket shower. Your stay includes all meals, beverages, laundry, emergency medical evacuation insurance (Personal Travel Insurance still required), National Parks Fees, 2 shared activities full per day, armchair safari and photographic hike (subject to Kanga Pan water level).

Mana Pools National Park, Zimbabwe

Located on the only private wilderness concession in Mana Pools National Park, the intimate Kanga Bush Camp overlooks a busy waterhole. Each of the six ensuite Meru-style safari tents boasts a comfortable bed, hot bucket shower and flush w.c. The tent's private veranda is the perfect place to sit back, relax and watch the activity at the busy waterhole. The guest lounge and dining areas are on a raised observation deck that enjoys the shade of some large trees, and guests can also enjoy a refreshing dip in the splash pool.

Guests enjoy twice-daily game drives in open 4x4 safari vehicles and interpretive bush walks, where they can learn to track wildlife with a professional guide. Canoeing safaris on the Zambezi River can also be organised in advance, as well as fullday excursions to River complete with hearty picnic lunches.

- Victoria Falls can be viewed from Zimbabwe and Zambia, the Zimbabwean side offers a greater number of spectacular viewing points. During the dry season between September and December, the eastern cataract on the Zambian side of the falls tends to dry up dramatically whist the Zimbabwean side continues to provide amazing views
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
