



## CARE OF THE LAND

- 3.6** | M hectares (9 M acres) of land
- 2 000** | km (1 242 mi.) of African coastline
- 17** | CO<sub>2</sub> kg/head Group Average – a 3.8 kg/head reduction in our direct carbon footprint since 2018
- 100** | % of lodges audited with an average 88% sustainability audit score
- 415** | Litre/head Group average water usage against target of 500 l/head
- 99** | % reduction in the use of plastic water bottles

## CARE OF THE WILDLIFE

- 72** | Leopards collared and tracked for 10 years as part of the MunYaWana/Panthera Leopard Research Programme on Phinda
- 5** | Lions translocated to Rwanda's Akagera N.P., reversing a 20-year local extinction
- 50** | Guar translocated to India's Bandhavgarh National Park, reversing a local extinction, with subsequent growth to 150
- 87** | Rhino translocated from South Africa to Botswana by Rhinos Without Borders to create new source populations
- 1 000** | TB-free buffalo translocated from &Beyond Phinda to other reserves
- 250** | Suni antelope translocated to 13 sites throughout Zanzibar from the small breeding group established on &Beyond Mnemba Island in 1993
- 38** | Aders' duiker from an original 5 reintroduced to &Beyond Mnemba Island in 2005
- 14 000** | Turtle hatchlings: average p.a. between &Beyond Mnemba and Vamizi Islands
- 18 000** | Conservation lessons
